GERMANY

During February 2010 came the sad news from Düsseldorf that Apostle Wilfried Baron had passed away after a short illness. He was well known to all, also here in Queensland, and had a very happy disposition, while being very sincere in the faith. He was almost 67 years old at the time of his passing and is survived by his wife Sis. Eveline, children and grandchildren.

During 1968 he was ordained as a Deacon, 1971 to Priest Office, 1981 Office Administrator, 1983 Evangelist, 1986 Trustee for the church in India where he made many visits, 1990 Bishop Office, and 1996 as an Apostle labouring to 2008 when he retired, but retained his responsibility for the church in India as well as some administration responsibility.

Apostle Lieberth chose the texts for the funeral service, Jeremiah 31:3 *"The Lord hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee"* and Genesis 15:15 *"And thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace"*.

PAKISTAN

Evangelist Edwin Riaz has completed his first visit of 12 weeks to Pakistan and is very pleased with the way the people embraced Apostolic faith as a means of preparation to the Kingdom of God. He was happy to return safely to his family in Canada. While there he arranged for the Church registration, held many discussions and seminars and Church Services. The Catechism, Book of Faith, Officers Guide, Pastoral Letters and Words of Life have been translated to their language and are being printed to aid in the work.

After many prayers and discussion with Apostle Cliff, it was decided he would ordain a

District Elder, a District Evangelist, three local Evangelists, ten Priests and eleven Deacons to continue the work in eleven communities. All must continue to pray that they will all be guided in the Lord's work.

The trip was not without incident. Ev. Edwin and Elder Earnest on their way to obtain church registration were involved in an accident from their motorbike when a car hit them and then sped off. Both had to be taken to hospital very badly bruised and shaken. As well, a bomb blast was set off. One church member had to be taken to hospital and the church gave some assistance.
