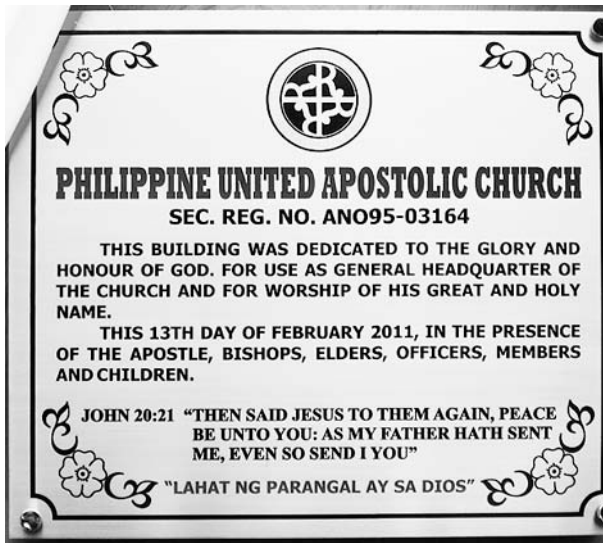

Three hour wait in Qantas lounge and then more security and at last all aboard. It was a full house, but Hostess said I was lucky the person in the seat next to me hadn't arrived so I had space to spread and forty winks now and then. Arrived in Brisbane 4 a.m. cleared customs, bus to domestic and now on the last leg waiting for Mackay flight.
